WHERE DID THE NAME APRIL COME FROM?

April takes its name from the Latin word *aperire*, meaning 'to open' (like flowers do in springtime). The Romans called the month *Aprilis*.

So, we are entering a new month in this year named after one of the wonders of spring!

In addition to the blooming of flowers we have the blooming of God's love during these weeks of the Easter season leading up to Pentecost in May.

When the Risen Lord appeared to the disciples, he did the same things he did as before the resurrection: he shared food and offered healing, forgiveness, and hope in God's name, and he called on his followers to continue this work.

The work of the gospel goes on by those touched by the presence and voice of Jesus. *"My sheep hear my voice. I know them, and they follow me."* (John 10:27).

The amount of worldly noise distracting us from our Savior's voice can be overwhelming. We can get hundreds of channels on cable TV. There are over 1 billion websites on the Internet. Every minute, 500 hours of new video are uploaded to YouTube. With all those voices seeking to distract us and keep our attention on things unrelated to faith, we need to make an intentional effort to focus on and prioritize Jesus.

Here are three things we can do to keep Jesus' voice resonating in our hearts and in our lives:

1. Pray daily. Connect yourself to Him and to His love and grace.

2. Worship weekly. Put yourself in the fellowship of other believers who gather around God's Word and the sacraments, where Jesus promises to be present.

3. Read scripture regularly (preferably daily). Through the Scriptures, we learn the foundations of faith and the record of God's people, including their joys, and like us, their struggles. We also see the love of God for His people then and for us today!

My prayer for you is that during this month of April, you fully enjoy the love of God, the fellowship of other believers, and that like Jesus' sheep – you know that He knows you, that you truly know Him, and that you follow Him where He leads!
